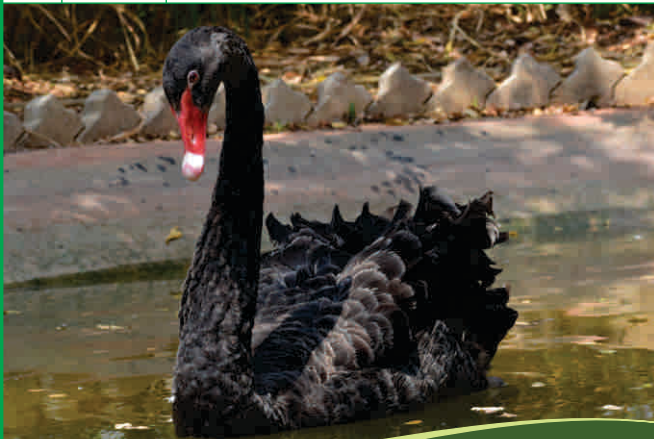

Ballari mini Zoo was established in the year 1981 to Spread awareness on conservation of wildlife, In later years due to lack of space the zoo could not meet the guidelines of central zoo authority. The action has been initiated to relocate the zoo near Kamalapur in Bilikal west reserve forest. The present zoo located in Bilikal Reseve forest at Kamalapur near Hosapete is renamed as "Sri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Zoological Park"

The Hampi zoo was established in the year 2017 with the new concept of safari and zoo. The zoo is spread over 141.59 Hacters Hampi zoo has Lion, Tiger and Herbivore safari and many other species can be seen in zoo area.
